Robert Elam Commissioners of Roads for Townships Township was appointed at the August Term 1874 of this Court to let to the County Undertaken the repairs of the Bridge across Foxons Mill pond. This day made report accompanied by Bond from the Undertaken both of which is ratified & confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed and it is ordered that the said Commissioner receive said bridge when completed according to contract and make report to Court.

The Commissioners appointed at the last Term of this Court to let to the County Undertaken the repairs of the Murre Ferry from the 1st of January 1875 to the 1st of January 1876, this day made report, which the Court upon inspection doth reject, and it is ordered that Joseph E. Gardner, James Vaughan & Augustus Crumpler be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, do select the same, and report to Court.
