

Deed of Gift, dated 8th day of May 1875, from Joel St. Cuthbert
and Wife to H. R. Griffin, (Trustee) for the benefit of
Ninny, Elizabeth and Brooks and also, conveying real
and personal estate, was admitted to record,
May the 11th 1875.

An Agreement, dated 1st day of May 1875, between W. H. Drury
