

On the Motion of Mrs. Rebecca L. Rowland, Executrix of Robert Rowland dec'd and it appearing to the Court that she has been made to pay \$11.04 taxes on 472 acres of land erroneously charged to Matthew Parker's Estate, for the year 1874, in Township, It is ordered that the Collector in said Township, refund the amount so erroneously paid by her, upon her returning to him, the original tax account paid by her.

* Geo. E. Beaton, is appointed Appraiser in the Township of Bayking to Supply the vacancy created by the removal from Office of David H. Kindred, the late Appraiser therefrom, thereupon the said Geo. E. Beaton together with W. M. Beaton his Security, (who justified in Court as to his Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars, Conditioned according to Law, of which Bond is ordered to be recorded the said Beaton also took and Subscribed the Cash required by Law.

On the Motion of Fannie Johnson, permission of the Court is hereby granted her, to bind her Infant child Caroline Johnson under the age of fourteen years, to Kymondy Cardano, according to Law.

The Court doth appoint Maria Miles Guardian of Peter Edwards orphan of Jack Edwards dec'd ^{under the age of fourteen years} and thereupon the said Maria Miles together with John C. Selma her Security, (who justified in Court as to his Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars, which Bond is ordered to be recorded.

On the Motion of Maria Miles Guardian of Peter Edwards orphan of Jack Edwards dec'd under the age of fourteen years, permission of the Court is granted her to bind her said ward Peter Edwards to John C. Selma, according to Law. And it is ordered that the said Master besides maintaining the Apprentices and teaching him reading, writing and common Arithmetic, including the Rule of three shall pay him upon his arriving to the age of twenty one years, the Sum of Seventy five dollars.

On the Motion of Thomas J. Buford and Sally R. Buford his wife and Mary E. Joseph and Caroline Actonette Kindred, the three last Defendants by John F. Kindred their next friends and Guardian, persons interested in the Estate of Samuel Orum dec'd against Wm. S. Goodings Executor of the last Will and Testament of Samuel Orum dec'd for a new Bond with Security, this day came the parties by their attorney

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
