

Joseph B. Pinner, after being on the 27th day of May 1875, duly elected attorney for the Commonwealth for this County, Commission on the first day of July 1875, and after said term of Office shall have expired, until his Successor is qualified to enter upon the discharge of the duties of said Office, this day appeared in Court, and qualified by taking the Oaths of Office, required by Law.

On the Motion of Henry Stanton and Lymanbrick Boardman and for reasons appearing to the Court they are exempt from the payment of taxes and levies in future, they being aged and infirm?

Ordered that the following accounts be paid, one in favor of J. B. Pinner attorney for the Commonwealth amounting to five dollars, one in favor of T. St. Vaughan Constable amounting to Eight ²⁵/₁₀₀ dollars, one in favor of T. St. Vaughan Constable amounting to Nine ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ dollars, one in favor of T. St. Vaughan Constable amounting to Twelve ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ dollars, one in favor of T. St. Vaughan Constable amounting to Nine ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ dollars and another in favor of T. St. Vaughan, Constable amounting to Six ⁹⁰/₁₀₀ dollars to be severally Certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment.

Ordered that J. S. Pinner Guardian of D. St. Jory be authorized to expend out of the principal of his said ward's Estate the sum of Two Hundred dollars for expenses incurred in the proper maintenance and Education of his said ward.

Ordered that Dimpsey Johnson, Richard A. Bennett & James Bishop and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to let for the work undertaken the repairs of the abutments to the Bridges on the Embankment at the Cypress Bridge, receive the same when completed according to Contract and make report to Court.

This Court being notified by the Court of Sale of Wright County that the Bridge over Blackwater River known as Pinner's Bridge needs being repaired or rebuilt, do hereby appoint C. M. Jones, A. T. Stephenson and Geo. W. Sperry to meet on the day of July next and confer with the Commissioners of Sale of Wright County as to the manner and conditions of doing the work, and report the result of their Conference to this Court. And it is ordered that a Copy of this Order be forwarded by mail to the Clerk of Sale of Wright County, Court.
