On the application of Thomas Vaughan & others Citizens of this County to have the original Indian Path so called Indian Road, established as a public Road. It is ordered that James McKello, R. S. Esq, Horro Esq, W. B. Saunders and R. T. Parsons who are appointed Commissioners for the purpose, do view the ground and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public if such Road shall be established as proposed, and especially whether any yard, Garden, Orchard or any part thereof will in such case have to be taken.

For the purpose of carrying into operation the provisions of the act of the General Assembly of Virginia entitled "an act to provide for working and keeping in order the Roads of the Commonwealth" approved March 20th 1875. The Board of the said app-

Pritchard to lay off the said District into Road precincts and add the lands to look on the public Roads in each precinct and to recommend suitable persons to be appointed Surveyors of each precinct, and report to the Court as soon as may be, their action in the premises.
