Joseph L. Parham a Justice of the Peace of this County, this day paid into Court to the Clerk thereof, Fifteen dollars, the amount of a fine imposed against George Brown, for a misdemeanor, and Three 33/100 dollars Costs, Twenty dollars, the amount of a fine imposed against James Brown for a misdemeanor, and Three 33/100 dollars Costs, and Twenty dollars the amount of a fine imposed against Sam. Long for a misdemeanor, and Three 33/100 dollars Costs.

Ordered that James R. West, A. G. Finkler, J. C. Atkinson, R. H. Byrke and James D. Janney (any three of whom may act) be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest bidder the filling up with Carrots the space between the Crankwork, at Jerusalem, caused by the washing up of the Third Bridge, connecting from the Bridge at Jerusalem. And the said Commissioners are directed to prepare Specifications for the guidance of the Contractor, so that the work may be done permanently. And they are ordered to make report to Court.

The Report of Proceedings in Precinct No. 1. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The Court satisfies ^{and approves} the report of Commissioners this day made, in regard to repairs of the Crankwork & Bridges at Jerusalem. And it appearing to the Court that King Knight has assigned his interest in the amount due him for said work to J. R. Edwards, ^{the Court doth request} the Board of Supervisors to issue their warrant to said Edwards for \$1000.00 (One thousand and sixty one 40/100 dollars) amount due King Knight as per said Report, and to J. W. Williams their warrant for (\$408.54) Four hundred and Eight 54/100 dollars amount due him as per said report.

Maggie Elizabeth Holland (sister of Sam. Holland dec'd, with the approval of the Court made choice of Walter Reed for her Guardian, and the Court doth assign the said Walter Reed as Guardian of Lemuel Holland also an orphan of the said Sam. Holland dec'd. And thereupon the said Walter Reed together with Wm. M. Beaton his Security, (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Ten Thousand dollars, conditioned as the law directs, which Bond is ordered to be recorded.
