were returned and ordered to be recorded.

Littleton R. Edwards, Clerk of this Court, upon the Consent of the Court, doth appoint James R. Tyler and Wm. H. Parker his Deputies, and thereupon the said Tyler & Parker qualified by taking the Oaths required by Law.

Robert Ridley, foreman, Geo. W. Vick, A. B. Ridley, M. M. Ungersunk, Cabot Everett, A. H. Lottin, B. F. Knight, B. F. McLenore, Lemuel Pease and Samuel R. Tracy, were sworn a special grand jury of Inquest for the body of this County, and having received their charge, withdrew, and after sometime returned into Court and presented the Indictments against Thomas and Geo. W. Blunt for Felony, a true bill. An Indictment against Thomas and Geo. W. Blunt for Felony "a true bill." they also made the following presentment, to wit: "That on the 15th day of March 1875, E. B. North, did unlawfully and fraudulently use and dispose of a Bank Note, of the Value of Five dollars, the property of Ben Evans, (which had been entrusted to him by said Evans,) upon the evidence of Ben Evans and A. B. Ridley, sworn in Court and sent to the grand jury." And the said Grand jury having nothing further to present were discharged.

It is Certified by the Court, upon satisfactory evidence produced before it, that the Will of the late Thomas Ridley of Westhampton County Va. which was duly proved in this Court on the 15th day of March A.D. 1875, was found among the valuable papers of said deceased, in his private Secretary, the Key to which was always kept by the deceased.

W. W. Briggs, Orris Moore, A. G. Ficklin, and J. J. Ficklin, Jr. are appointed Commissioners to examine and if necessary let for repairs the Bridge over Cuscuta Swamp near J. J. Ficklin's, receive the same when completed according to Contract, and make report to Court.

Ordered that H. M. Butts, Jas. E. Selwell, & Robert Ridley, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, to let to the Court Undertaker the repairs of the Tamm's Bridge, receive the work when completed (having first taken Bond with good Security from the Undertaker, for the faithful performance of his Contract,) and make report to Court.

Ordered that R. A. Barrett, James L. Bishop, and Vempsey Johnson, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to let to the Court Undertaker the repairs of the Stick Neck Bridge, in this County, take Bond and Security from the Undertaker, for the faithful performance of his Contract, and make report to Court.
