

R. H. Blight, B. F. Vickers and J. H. Devany, Commissioners appointed at the June Term last of this Court, to let to the lowest bidder the repairing of the Small Bridge on the Embankment near H. P. Phipps White house and the temporary repairs of the Indian Bridge, this day made their Report according to the same, which is ratified and confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed.

R. H. Blight, James R. West and A. C. Atkinson, three of the Commissioners appointed at the June Term last of this Court to let to the lowest bidder the filling up of the hole at the other Bridge near Jerusalem, and also the repairing of the abutments at Cypress gut Bridge and widen the embankment at the last Bridge near the White house, and fill up all holes in the embankment from the first Bridge near the White house to the Indian Bridge according to the Specifications filed in the Clerk's Office, this day made their Report, accompanied by Specifications and Bond from the Undertaker, which is ratified and confirmed by the Court, and ordered to be filed. And it is ordered that the said Commissioners receive said work upon completion according to Contract, and make report to Court.

The February of August Term of this Court and designated by the Court, as Term for which a Grand Jury and to be summoned.

On the motion of Jas. E. Peters, Guardian of Margaret Ann Prineas, Appellant & Joseph Prineas dec. he is allowed to expend the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars of the principal of his said ward's Estate for her support &c.
