 Edwards, Charles Vaughan, John L. Beale, Geo. H. Vardens, B. H. Harrison,
 Simeon Dickins, John E. Prince and Wm. E. Johnson, above sworn a grand
 jury of inquest for the body of this County, and having received their
 charge upon oath, and after sometime returned into Court and presented
 an indictment against Julius Jones, for Murder, "at true bill."
 An indictment against C. D. Scott, for "wrongfully and fraudulently
 by using and disposing of another's money" "at true bill."
 They also made the following presentments to wit: "We present
 Robert J. Parker for making an assault and battery on the
 person of Wm. H. Vaughan on the 8th day of Nov. 1874, in Southampton
 County upon the evidence of Robert J. Holland and Wm. H. Vaughan,
 sworn in Court and sent to the grand jury at their request."
 We present Robert Butts for making an assault and battery on the
 person of Lewis Klemm, on the 10th day of August, in Southampton
 County upon the evidence of Lewis Klemm, sworn in Court and sent
 to the Grand Jury at their request." "We present Esmer Holtz
 for making an assault and battery on the person of Benjamin
 Francis on the 18th day of August 1875, in Southampton County,
 upon the evidence of Benjamin Francis sworn in Open Court,
 and sent to the Grand Jury." "We request that Eugene Jones Colored,
 be summoned before the next Grand Jury" And the said Grand Jury
 having nothing further to present were discharged.

The Commissioners appointed at the March Term 1875, of the Court, to let
 to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge between Swanton
 and Kittery Station across the Stream near Saine Place, this day
 made report, which is ratified and confirmed by the Court, and
 ordered to be filed.

The Court doth appoint Exam Harris & J. H. Johnson Processors in
 Precinct No. 11. in the place of Walter Harding and S. I. Pope
 who declines to act.

Ordered that W. A. Bell, W. W. White and Geo. W. Stephenson,
 be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to examine the
 Cassano Bridge for abutments, and if they deem it necessary
 let the same to the lowest undertaker, and make report to the Court.

Ordered that Jos. G. Crumpler, as Commissioner purchase a
 rope for the use of the Ferry at Mauro, and report to the Court.
