 custody of the jailer of this Court, and having already arraigned pleaded not
 guilty to the indictment, and a panel of six persons summoned by the Sheriff
 examined by the Court, and found free from all legal exceptions, and found free
 from all legal exceptions and qualified to serve as jurors according to law.
 They were the accused personally challenged from the jury, and the
 twelve in all; J. J. Bishop, Walter Bishop, James B. Bond, Mills & Bley,
 W. H. Urquhart, M. M. Urquhart, Joseph B. Williams, Andrew
 Edwards, Warren Edwards, James R. West, J. J. Watkins and Wm. H.
 Ferguson, who being elected, tried and sworn the truth of and upon
 the premises to speak and having heard the evidence upon this (last)
 day "The Jury find the prisoner not guilty." And prosecution
 being made as the manner is and nothing further appearing to
 being alleged against the prisoner he is discharged from custody.

The Court certifies that William Urquhart, Jno. W. Holmes, M. M. Urquhart,
 James H. Versey, Wm. J. Gilbert, J. E. Howe, J. H. Cutchins, Suggins
 Vaughan, Jas. H. Darden, William Edwards, Thomas W. Vaughan, John L.
 Beale, Geo. H. Darden, B. F. Harrison, J. P. Dickson, John E. Finner and
 W. E. Johnson are entitled to one dollar each, for their services
 as grand jurors to be paid out of the County treasury.

The Court certifies that Geo. W. Bradshaw, D. T. Webb, J. H. Johnson, J. H.
 Barnes, R. T. Vaughan, Jas. L. Bishop, J. E. Cobb, Augustus Campbell, R. H. Cobb, James
 Vaughan, Henry Ferguson, J. P. Thomas are entitled to one dollar each for their services
 as jurors in the trials of prosecutions for misdemeanors. To be paid out of the public treasury.

Ordered that a copy of the presentments of the grand jury this day made against Robert
 J. Parker, Robert Batts and Osmore Holt be certified to a Justice of the Peace for the
 County to be proceeded upon according to law.

James H. Barnes a Justice of the Peace of this County this day paid into Court in full
 block thereof, five dollars, the amount of a fine imposed against Sarah Guiter for a misdemeanor.

Emmett Moxley, Terry Beale, J. J. Pretlow Jr and William Wells here in Court
 severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the
 sum of One hundred dollars, of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements
 for the use of the said Commonwealth. Yet upon this condition if the said
 Emmett Moxley, Terry Beale, J. J. Pretlow Jr and Wm. Wells do severally make
 their personal appearance before this Court by 10 o'clock tomorrow morning and give
 such evidence as they know or believe on behalf of the Commonwealth against James Jagers
 who stands indicted of murder and shall not depart without leave of the said Court then the
 above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
