The Commissioners in this case, this day made their Report, which is
continued for explanation.

Berry Mason, who stands bound by recognizance entered into before Justice
Parker, Justice of the Peace of this County, for his appearance here this
day to answer the Commonwealth of Pa. Concerning a certain Murder
Mason and stealing six pieces of linen, which with the said Berry
Mason stands charged, was this day solemnly called but could not
therefore on the motion of the Attorney for the Commonwealth,
it is ordered that the writ of Habeas Corpus be issued against the
said Berry Mason, and John Trake his Security, returnable here on
the first day of the next Term of this Court.

Ordered that the following accounts be paid, one in favor of Mrs Josephine
