

X Jos: L. Crumpler, who was appointed at the last term of the Court Commissioner to purchase a rope for the Homer Ferry, this day made a report, which is ratified and confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed.

X On the application of James H. Moore, Esq: who wishes to keep an ordinary at Franklin's Defeat in this County - from the first day of October 1875 to 30th day of April 1876 - The Court being satisfied after hearing the testimony in favor of the application, and being of opinion ^{with respect} that the place where the same is to be kept, is suitable and convenient, and that the applicants are persons of sobriety and good character, and that they have paid to the proper officer the tax required by law to be paid on said license.

11 The Commissioners appointed at the last term of the Court, to let the repairs of "Watson's Bridge," this day made their report, which is ratified and confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed.

The Commissioners appointed at the same term of the Court of the present year (1875) to let the repairs of the "Cypress Bridge and Outbankments and Cule Bridges connected therewith," this day made their report, which is ratified and confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed.

X Commissioners appointed at this term of the Court, to view the road "known as" "Sowers Road," this day made their report, which is continued for further hearing.

X No exceptions being filed to either of the reports of the Commissioners appointed to lay off the "Municipal Districts" in "Jerusalem and Dressingville" in road precincts which were returned at the last term of this Court. The said reports stand confirmed. And thereupon the Court doth appoint Robert H. Williams Surveyor of road in precinct No: 51 "From fork of road to fork of road at Ezra Gardner's farm. He assigns the lands on the farms of J. P. Vick, Mrs Mary Williams, R. H. Williams, John Cobb, E. T. Charles, J. Charles, Eli Drake, J. L. Williams, C. J. Williams, C. H. Williams, Moses Joyner, J. R. Ricks, Dr. D. J. Prellow &c: on west side of said road. Robt: H. Williams Surveyor."

Ezra H. Vick Surveyor in precinct No: 52. "From old Vicksville to fork of road at Dr: P. Davis." Lands allotted to work thereon, from the farms of G. H. Vick, Mrs Rebecca Briggs, H. J. Cobb, Gra: Bryant."

X Gra: Williams, Surveyor in precinct No: 53. From Dr: P. Davis to Bridge at Jerusalem. Lands allotted from the farms of Dr: Davis, P. Davis, Gra: Williams, Mrs Whitehead, Scarborough farm Dr: P. Davis, John J. Kindred, C. Gardner, Jerusalem to the Bridge.
