

The Commissioners appointed at the July term last of this Court to let the repairs of the Tarrant Bridge this day made report receiving the same, which is ratified and confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed and a copy thereof be certified to the Board of Supervisors.

The Commissioners appointed at the August term last of this Court, to let the repairs of the Cypress Bridge, this day made an additional report, which is ratified and confirmed by the Court, and ordered to be filed, and a copy thereof be certified to the Board of Supervisors.

The Commissioners appointed at the term of this Court, last, to let the repairs of the Parcell's Bridge & Embankment this day made report, which is ratified and confirmed by the Court, and ordered to be filed, and a copy thereof be certified to the Board of Supervisors.

The Commissioners appointed at the September term of this Court last to let the repairs of the Bridge across Leavick Swamp, called Cranfills Bridge, this day made report which is ratified and confirmed by the Court, and ordered to be filed. Borth take Bond of Security from the undertaker for the faithful performance of his Contract, receive the same when completed according to Contract and make report to Court.

Ordered that the report of T. de Bordenave, B. Brown & J. P. Bryant Commissioners returned to the September term of this Court, with a view to reestablish the cross Road as Brown had, be recommended to the same Commissioners also and directed to let to the County Sudden the opening and putting in good repair the said Road, take bond of Security of the Contractor, conditioned for the faithful performance of the Contract, and make report thereof to Court.
