 returned, Confirmed & Ordered to be recorded.

At the Court of Sessions, Term of Wm. J. Adams, Geo. of Stephens and Mary Whitfield, at W. Suffolk, Thomas  
 Vaughan & J. B. Davidson were sworn a Special Grand jury of request for the body of the  
 County, and having received their charge withdrew and after deliberate retirement into  
 Court and presented the Indictments against John J. Jones & George A. Foster for murder,  
 "It true bill." An Indictment against Richard Broadhead for battery, "It true bill."  
 An Indictment against David Sumner & others, for disturbing religious worship, "It true bill."  
 An Indictment against Miles E. Vick for assault & battery, "It true bill."  
 An Indictment against G. P. Vaughan for a misdemeanor, "It true bill."  
 An Information against Henry Gordon & Jacob Karrison for a misdemeanor.  
 An Information against Peter Wingard for a misdemeanor. "It true bill."  
 They also made the following presentment to wit, "We present Richard Karrison for  
 violating an assault & battery upon the person of Richard Broadhead, on the  
 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 1875, in the County of Dorchester, upon the evidence of  
 Wm. J. Howard, sworn in Court, and sent before the Grand jury. And the said Grand jury  
 & having returned further to present upon discharge."

 Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Commonwealth recover against the

 And the defendant having been present in Court it is ordered that he be committed  
 to the jail of this County until the judgment aforesaid is satisfied, or until he  
 is otherwise discharged by due course of law.
