The Court being fully satisfied that the applicant is a person of sobriety and good character, and that the place where he will keep Ordinary is to be kept is suitable convenient and suitable, and that he is provided with the necessary accommodations for man or horse, as provided in the 69th Section of the Act Debating March 1st, 1875, and that the tax required by law has been paid to the proper officer.

Ordered that H. S. Barnard, B. C. Donnell and R. H. Durham, Commissioners, let to the lowest bidder the repairs of Bridge across Angelia, near H. S. Barnard, receive the same when completed according to contracts and make report to Court.

On motion of Alfred Powell, and for reason appearing to the Court, he is exempt from the payment of taxes and levies in future, being aged and infirm.

On motion of Samuel Parker, it is ordered, that license be granted him for the sale of Religious Works, Books &c; and payment of a nominal tax.

The Commissioners appointed at the November Term of this Court last, to repair the Bowes Road with a view to re-establish said road, this day made their report, which is disapproved by the Court.
