Indictment for Forgery

The Defendant was this day again solemnly called but came not. Whereupon the Sheriff of this County, made return upon the writ of Capias last returned against the Defendant, that at his County Court held for the said County, at the Court-house thereof on the 5th of May 1875, the said John D. A. Benham was demanded a third time and did not appear: and at a County Court held for the County aforesaid on the third Monday in June 1875, the said John D. A. Benham was demanded a fourth time and did not appear: And at a County Court held for the County aforesaid on the third Monday in July 1875, the said John D. A. Benham was demanded a fifth time and did appear. Therefore the said John D. A. Benham by the Court of this County and according to the law and Customs of this Commonwealth, is outlawed. And whereupon on motion of the Attorney for the Commonwealth, it is ordered that the writ of Capias last returned against the said John D. A. Benham returnable here on the first day of the next term.

Report of processions in forcible No. 15, was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that James O. Shaw, Treasurer of Southampton County, out of the County pay to A. J. Stephens the sum of \$18.50, to A. L. Helms \$12.00, to Mr. W. Clayton \$12.00, to H. B. Windick \$6.45⁰⁰ to David Baycomb \$6.00 for their services as processions.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning ten o'clock.
