

Ordered that the two accounts of T. H. Vanhook, Constable, amounting to New Dollars and five Cents, each, be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment.

The Commissioner appointed at the November Term last of this Court, to let the repairs of Sunday Bridge, across Round Hill Swamp, this day made report, which is satisfactory and conformable to the Court and ordered to be filed. And it is ordered that the same Commissioner to quit, Geo. Brady, Esq. A. J. Lawrence Esq. of Stephentown take Bond & Security from the Undertaker, for the faithful performance of his Contract, receive the same when completed and make report to Court.

The Commissioner appointed at the July Term last of this Court, to examine & let the Sunday across Quivers road, this day made report, which is ordered to be filed on (October) until the next term.

W. H. Burges personally appeared before Peter C. Holmes, a Justice of the Peace for this County, and made Oath that James Brown is justly indebted to him in the sum of fifty four dollars and thirty six Cents, for (Cotton in the Court, now due, and that to the best of his belief the said James Brown intends to remove his effects out of this State, so that there will shortly be no person sufficient to satisfy the claim of the said Richard W. Burges, whose judgment is obtained thereon only the ordinary process of law to, and to obtain such judgment, and the justice having issued an attachment against the said James Brown and the Officer to whom it is directed having returned that he has attached one horse and one cart of the Defendant Brown (this day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard and the evidence adduced considered, and it being proved to the Court that the said James Brown is justly indebted to the Plaintiff in the sum of thirty two dollars, it is thereupon considered by the Court, that the Plaintiff recover against the said James Brown, the said thirty two dollars, and his costs by him in this behalf expended. And that the Officer who levied the said attachment make sale of the property according to law and apply the proceeds thereof, as far as necessary to the satisfaction of this judgment, the balance if any return to the defendant and return an account of such sale to the Court.

The Court did appoint Elizabeth M. Mepentury Guardian of Helen C. Mepentury orphan of William A. Mepentury dec. and thereupon the said Elizabeth M. Mepentury signed with Attorney of Fitchburg for her Security, under judgment in Court as in her Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of One Hundred dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which Bond is ordered to be recorded.

John James Goodhue & George Allen, who have been duly licensed to practice the law in the Court of this Commonwealth, on their oaths have been sworn in this Court, and thereupon they took the Oaths required by law.

On the Motion of Sampson Deane, and for reasons appearing to the Court, he is excused from the payment of Fees being in Jail, he being aged and infirm.
