

Said Salinas Vick, did not the vice assigned in due form.

Ordered that Samuel Ferguson, Miles Horner, & L. Warren, Geo. & Gordon (in any other of them) ^{being first duly sworn for the purpose} do appraise all the goods and Chattels of Salinas Vick, do. and return the appraisement under their hands as the law directs.

Ordered that Harriet Edwards widow of Harrow Edwards did relinquishing her right to qualify in the Estate of her deceased husband in favor of George H. Wells. Whereupon the said George H. Wells, who reads Court according to law, and together with James Vaughan and Justice R. Edwards her Securities, (who qualified in Court as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Six Thousand dollars, Conditioned according to law, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said George H. Wells for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Harrow Edwards, do. in due form.

Ordered that James Vaughan, John Enbush & J. Watkins being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods and Chattels of Harrow Edwards, do. and return the appraisement under their hands as the law directs.

Ordered that John Enbush for Queen White & Mrs. Mond be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners, to examine, and if necessary, let in the Street Undertaker, the repairs of the Nottingham Square Bridge, take Bond and Security from the Undertaker for the faithful performance of his Contract, and make report to Court.

The Commissioners appointed at the September Term last of this Court to let in the Street Undertaker the repairs of the Bridge, Endorsment across the public Road at Mansfield Mills this day made report, accompanied by Specifications, which is satisfied and confirmed by the Court, and ordered to be filed. And it is ordered that the same Commissioners to act, Geo. H. Lawrence, William Edwards & Robert W. Leroy take bond and security from the Undertaker for the faithful performance of their Contract, receive the work when completed and make report to Court.

The bonds on the farm of Miss Thomas Edwards are assigned to the road commission from Westchester to the State line.

In the Matter of J. E. Harris. It is ordered that Wm. Briggs Sheriff of the County take into his hands the Estate of Wm. Mary Harris, and administer the same as the law directs, she being dead over three months and no person applying for administration on said Estate.

In the Matter of F. H. Vaughan. It is ordered that the Estate of Beulah Burgess do be committed to the hands of Wm. Briggs Sheriff of the County, who will administer the same as the law directs, he being dead over three months and no person applying for administration on said Estate.

Ordered that James Holmes who is hereby appointed a Commissioner for the purpose, let in the Street Undertaker the Repairing of road from Square Bridge across Blackwater River for twelve months ending 31st day of December 1896.
