

The last will and Testament of Eli Spring was proved by the Oaths of Wm. C. Johnson and Wm. H. Jenkins the Subscribing witnesses thereto, and Codrus to be recorded. And on the petition of George H. Spring the Executor therein named, who was oath according to law, and together with C. H. Bailey, Wm. H. Jenkins and Wm. C. Johnson, his Securers, (who justified as Oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five hundred dollars, conditioned as the last directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said George H. Spring for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

St. Vaughan (insoluble amounting to \$8.65) and another in favor of Sara Vaughan, (insoluble amounting to \$8.85) be severally certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts, for his examination and payment.

The Court doth appoint Jm. Brown Guardian of Henry Hymer, thereupon the said Jm. Brown entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five dollars (but without security, the Court requiring none,) conditioned according to law, which bond is ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of John Durlow Jr. and Thomas Durlow Jr., who made as the last directs and together with S. D. Durlow, S. B. Durlow and A. H. Durlow, their securers, (who justified in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of eighty thousand dollars, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted them for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Thomas D. Durlow dec. in due form.

Ordered that J. D. Durlow, Jm. A. Brown, J. H. Briggs and C. C. Williams, (or any three of them,) having first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods and chattels of Thomas J. Durlow dec. and return the appraisement under their hands as the last directs.

Wm. Bradshaw, is appointed Comr. of the Estate of Vincent S. Dole dec. during the contest about the will of the said Dole, and thereupon the said Wm. Bradshaw, together with Richard M. Stephenson, J. H. Briggs, Edwin Bradshaw, Jm. S. Curran, Saml. Vaughan, L. C. Cobb and Jm. A. Stendley, his securers (all justified in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of thirty thousand dollars, conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded.
