

Tuesday Morning March 21st 1876. Present,

The Hon. J. W. Weymouth, Judge,

The Court certifying that William Edwards, Jno. H. Rodams, Wm. J. Coby, Alfred Rogers, Geo. W. Spring and James E. Rens, are entitled to law dollar each, for their services this term, as grand jurors, to be paid out of the County bag.

On the application of R. C. Cornshead who desires to ~~be~~ distribute or distribute his religious tracts, pamphlets, and the Court being satisfied that he is a person of good character and a proper person as shown to Confide the trust of holding or distributing such Books, with dissent the Appellate grand Jurors & Justice with a Unanimous vote only under Section 32 Chapter 24 Code of Virginia 1873.

Ordered that the accounts of D. F. McLeone Quabbe, amounting to Three ~~hundred~~ dollars and the Sher amounting to Three ~~hundred~~ dollars be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment.

Ordered that the account of Delay Carson, (Quabbe, amounting to Ten ~~hundred~~ dollars be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment.

Anderson King, who stands Indicted of Murder was again led to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and the jury before yesterday for his trial was brought into Court by the Sheriff of this County, and was ~~then~~ brought out of Court to present his Verdict and after some time returned into Court and upon their Oaths do say, "We the jury find the Prisoner guilty of Murder in the 2nd Degree, and ascertaining his term of imprisonment to be 15 years in the Penitentiary." And it being demanded of him the said Anderson King if anything for himself he had or knew to say why the Court here should not proceed to pronounce judgment against him according to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in ~~defense~~ of Judgment, it is considered by the Court that the said Anderson King be imprisoned in the Penitentiary by the Commonwealth for the term of Eighteen years the period by the jury in their Verdict ascertained. And it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County do as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court remove and safely convey the said Anderson King from the jail of this County to the Penitentiary of the Commonwealth, where he be kept imprisoned, and treated in the manner directed by law. And thereupon the said Anderson King is remanded to jail.
