this term, & grand jury, to be paid out of the County budget.

On the application of H C Compton also desiring to have a distribute or be delayed
Bills newspaper and the Court being satisfied that he is a person of good character
and a proper person or allow to receive the trust of holding or distributing such
Bills, with desire the Sheriff to grant him a License with a Commission
for only under Section 32 Chapter 34 Code of Virginia 1873.

Ordered that the account of B T McSweeney Constable, accounting to
the sum of four dollars and the other amounting to three dollars be certified
to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment.

Ordered that the account of Delroy Garrison, Constable, accounting to sum
of four dollars be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his
examination and payment.

Anderson Hines who stands indicted of Murder was again sent to the bar
in custody by the Justice of the Court, and the Jury, were yesterday for his
trial were brought into Court by the Sheriff of this County, and were sent
out of Court in Pursuit of this Verdict and after some time returned into Court
and upon this Court do say "We the Jury find the Prisoner guilty of
Murder in the 2^d Degree, and according his term of imprisonment to
be 18 years in the Penitentiary." And it being demanded of him the said
Anderson Hines if anything for himself he had or would to say why the said
Court should proceed to pronounce judgment against him according to law,
he said "I have nothing to say or allege in behalf of myself, it is considered
and thinking being offered or alleged in behalf of myself, it is considered
by the Court that the said Anderson Hines be imprisoned in the Penitentiary
of this Commonwealth for the term of eighteen years the period by the
jury in their Verdict ascertained. And it is ordered that the Sheriff
of this County do as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court
remove said Anderson Hines from the jail of this
Court to the Penitentiary of this Commonwealth there to be kept
imprisoned, and treated in the manner directed by law. And
hereafter the said Anderson Hines is remanded to jail.
