

William M. Briggs, Sheriff of this County, this day, with the Consent of the Court, did appoint T. H. Vaughan, his Deputy, whereupon the said Vaughan qualified by taking the several Oaths required by Law.

Salathiel Lewis who stands indicted by Felony appeared in Court according to the Condition of his recognizance entered into before this Court at the last term thereof and was set to the bar in Courtday of the Sheriff of this County and being there, arraigned pleaded not guilty to the Indictment, and a panel of twelve persons of the shire was summoned by the Sheriff were examined by the Court found free from all legal exception and qualified to serve as jurors according to Law. Thereupon the accused premeditatedly challenged four of the jurors, and of the remaining seven to wit, James Vaughan, Henry S. Barkman, Alexander Knight, J. H. Thomas, M. S. Ridley, Geo. W. Thomas, Reckman Van Gas & Garden, James R. Penson, J. D. Westbrook, R. S. Barkman and John S. Turner, who were elected tried and sworn, the last of and upon the promise to speak, and leaving peacefully here the witness, were with the Consent of the Prisoner Committed to the Custody of the Sheriff of this County, who is directed to keep them together, without Communication with any other person, and cause them to appear here tomorrow Morning at Nine O'clock. Whereupon an Oath was administered to Wm M. Briggs Sheriff of this County, and to T. H. Vaughan, his Deputy to the following effect, "You shall well and truly, to the best of your ability, keep this group, and neither speak to them yourself, nor suffer any other person to speak to them touching any matter relative to this trial, until they return into Court tomorrow Morning." And thereupon on the Motion of the said Salathiel Lewis, he is allowed to give bail, himself to be bound in the sum of one thousand dollars, with good Security in the like sum, of one thousand dollars, whereupon the said Lewis, with James S. Borden his Security (who justified in Court as to his Sufficiency) here in Court acknowledged themselves, subject to the Commencement of Virginia, the said Lewis in the sum of one thousand dollars, and the said James S. Borden in the like sum of one thousand dollars, of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements to be seized, yet upon other Condition that if the said Salathiel Lewis shall make his personal appearance before this Court by Nine O'clock tomorrow Morning, to answer the Commencement of and concerning the Felony of which he stands indicted, and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court, that the above recognizance to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until tomorrow Morning 9 O'clock.
