

The Commissioners appointed at the last Term of this Court to be the
 referees of the above Survey Bridge, this day make report, which is
 ratified and confirmed by the Court and ordered by the Court that
 it be ordered that the same Commissioners, to wit, A. J. Stephens,
 W. M. Clayton, and Geo. W. Phipps, take bond and Security from the
 Undertaker for the faithful performance of his Contract, receive the
 same when completed, and make report to Court.

The Court deeming it expedient, doth authorize, and requires, James R. [?]
 and John S. DeRice, two of the Commissioners, ^{in charge} to take
 full account of Fiduciaries, Under an Act of the General Assembly
 of Virginia, Chapter 63, approved February 12th 1876.

On the Motion of Alfred Dyer, and for reasons appearing to the Court, he
 is exempted from the payment of Taxes and duties in future, he being
 aged and infirm.

Ordered that the following accounts, to wit, be in favor of A. J. Stephens
 and Geo. W. Phipps, amounting to Forty four dollars and forty five Cents, due in
 favor of E. D. Weston Special Constable, amounting to Twenty three
 dollars and two Cents, and be in favor of T. H. Vanyan, Constable,
 amounting to Eight dollars and twenty five Cents, be received by the
 Clerk of the Court for the Auditor of Public Accounts, for his compensation and
 delivered to the payee.

On the Motion of Emory Whitehead, and for reasons appearing to the Court,
 he is exempted from the payment of Taxes and duties in future, he being
 aged and infirm.

Ordered that D. J. Wells, J. C. Wells and William Edwards, be and they
 are hereby appointed Commissioners to examine and if necessary
 let to the Court Undertaker, the repairs of the Bridge on
 Cumberland River, near Hollister Mills, on the Road to Jerusalem, take
 bond and Security from the Undertaker, for the faithful performance
 of his Contract, and make report to Court.

A License is this day granted. Wm. J. Voth, on his application to
 retail ardent Spirits to be drawn from the place to be sold at the
 Store at Bradshaw's Mill in this County for the period beginning
 on the first day of July 1876, and expiring on the 30th day of
 April 1877, the Court being satisfied that the applicant is a
 person of Sobriety and good character, and that the place to be
 sold is suitable and convenient, and that the law required by
 the Court be paid to the proper Officer.
