

declined, tried and given the verdict of and upon the promise to speak, and having heard the evidence, upon their oath do say, "We the jury find the prisoner guilty, and sentence him to imprisonment in the County Jail for thirty days." And thereupon it being demanded of him, the said James Deane, if anything for himself he had or knew to say, why the Court should not proceed to pronounce judgment against him, according to law, and speaking being offered and allowed in delay of judgment, it is considered by the Court, that the said James Deane be imprisoned in the jail of this County for the period of thirty days the time by the laws in that respect ascertained, and thereafter until she pays the costs of this prosecution. And thereupon the said James Deane is committed to jail.

On the motion of Wm. H. Daughtry and John W. Beaton for leave to open a new road to commence at a point on the road leading from Jeffersonville to Riddickswood near Beth. Williams in Wayne and Thompson Land, and running in a general direction to the south west ending to "Kimbroughs Mill". The Commissioners appointed at the April Term last of this Court to "view the ground and report to the Court the convenience and inconvenience that will result as well to individuals, as to the public of such road shall be established as proposed, and especially directed any yard, garden, orchard or any part thereof will in such case have to be taken." This day made their report, whereupon it is ordered that Benjamin J. Byrnes, and James T. Lee, the proprietors of the said Land, be summoned to the first day of the next Term of this Court, to show cause, if any they can, why the said road should not be opened as proposed.

Ordered that the account of Joseph B. Davis, attorney for the Command to W. W. Briggs in this Court, amounting by thirty dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts, for his examination and payment.

Ordered that the account of James C. Seibert, Treasurer of this County, amounting to thirty six dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts, for his examination and payment.

Ordered that the account of W. W. Briggs Sheriff of this County, amounting to Eight $\frac{3}{100}$ dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his Examination and payment.

Ordered that the account of W. W. Briggs Sheriff of this County, amounting by Seven $\frac{9}{100}$ dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his Examination and payment.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned, until tomorrow morning ten o'clock.
