Davis was demanded a fifth time and did not appear. Wherefore the said A. B. Davis by the judgment of this Court, and according to the laws and Customs of this Commonwealth is captured and imprisoned in the Jail of the Sheriff of the County of Southampton, it is ordered that the writ of Habeas Corpus be awarded against the said A. B. Davis, returnable here on the first day of the next Term.
