Meddons returnable at this Court, and the Court do to return the said attachment was directed having returned that he had served the same by delivery of a copy thereof to Hutchings Lewis. This day came the Plaintiff by his attorney and for reasons appearing to the Court the said attachment is continued until next term, at the Court of the Dependents.

Ordered that W. H. White, A. H. Medicus & W. H. Coby (who are being appointed Commissioners for the purpose, do let to the Court undertaker the repairs of Ruffin's Bridge near the farm of W. H. Coby and make report to Court.

Ordered that S. B. Wells, J. P. Boykin & Benj. Bristol, be appointed Commissioners to let to the Court undertaker the repairs of Seacrest Bridge, and make report to Court.

Ordered that Wm. Prince, J. S. Thomas and Thos. Applewhite be appointed Commissioners to let to the Court undertaker the repairs of the Bridge across Applewhite's Mill ^{dam} and report to Court.

Ordered that Thos. Little, Wm. B. Sanders & E. C. Haget be appointed Commissioners to let to the Court undertaker the repairs of Henry's Bridge across the Three Creeks, and make report to Court.

The Commissioners appointed at the Term of this Court, do let the rebuilding of the Bridge across Blair's Mill Swamp, this day made their report receiving the same, which is read and confirmed by the Court, and ordered to be filed.

A. S. Stephenson, this day tendered his resignation as Surveyor of the Road from Little Sarropps Swamp to Blackwater Road, which the Court accepts.
