

The Commissioners appointed at the Term of this Court, to let the repairs of the Embankment on the road leading from Spaulding's Mill to Nicholas's Store, this day made report, which is satisfied & confirmed by the Court, and ordered to be filed. And it is ordered that J. G. Walling, Julius Dillman, receive the same when completed according to Contract, and make report to Court.

The Commissioners appointed to examine & let to the County, Undertaken the repairs of the Stone Bridge made report, which is satisfied & confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed.

The Commissioners appointed to examine & receive the Peterway Bridge across the Stone Crabs, made report, receiving the same, which is satisfied and confirmed by the Court, and ordered to be filed.

A License is this day granted to M. C. G. & Co. S. Lewis and C. S. Dunning, their application to sell Wine, ardent Spirits, Malt Liquors, or any mixture of them, at their store located in this County, to be drunk at and from the place of sale, for the period beginning on the 20th day of November 1876, and expiring on the thirtieth day of April 1877, the Court being fully satisfied that the applicants are persons of sobriety and good character, and that the place of business is convenient and suitable, and that the tax required by law, has been paid to the proper Officer.

A License is this day granted to C. W. Nicholson, at his application to sell wine, ardent spirits, Malt Liquors, or any mixture of them, at his Store in this County, to be drunk from the place of sale, for the period beginning on the 20th day of November 1876, and expiring on the thirtieth day of April 1877, the Court being fully satisfied that the applicant is a person of sobriety and good character and that the place of business is convenient and suitable, and that the tax required by law, has been paid to the proper Officer.

Dunning Camp this day tendered his resignation as Surgo of the Road, in Precinct ch. 10. Which is approved by the Court.

The Court did appoint Wm. A. Whitcomb, Surgo of the road in Precinct ch. 10. in the place of Dunning Camp this day resigned.

On the Motion of Chesterfield Bowles he is exempt from the payment of Taxes and being in future he being age and infirm.

Richard A. Prester, one of the Executors named in the last Will and Testa of J. L. G. paid bond of Tharing & Prester did heretofore recorded in this Court, after made oath according to law and together with Alfred J. Stephenson & Wm. M. Beecher their Securities (also justified on Oath as to their Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two thousand dollars, conditioned according to law, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Richard A. Prester for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.
