deceased and return the appraisement under their hands as taken and
directed.

Charles E. Morgan, a person of unknown residence; Morgan appears before the Court
& Morgan has security (who justified on Oath as to his Sufficiency) entered
into and acknowledged a Bond in the Sum of One Thousand dollars,
Conditioned according to Law, which bond is ordered to be recorded.
