

Charles H. Lawrence, J.P. Darden, who was appointed at the May Term last of this Court, Special Policemen, this day qualified by taking the Oaths required by law.

Rufus C. Darden is by the Court appointed Guardian of the person of Charles Darden, a person of unsound mind, Incapable of taking care of himself, with William Edwards & Geo. W. Lawrence his Securities (who justified in Oath as to their sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded.

On the Motion of Thomas S. Harvey, who made Oath according to law, together with Joseph H. Davis, Albert M. Kasher & Thos. R. Purvis Jr. his Securities (who justified in Oath as to their sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Ten thousand dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Thos. S. Harvey for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Thomas R. Russell dec'd. in due form.

Ordered that W. T. Adams, J. R. Kiser, David Turner, Thos. M. Kiser & R. H. Turner, or any three of them, (being first duly sworn for this purpose,) do appraise all the goods of Charles & Thomas R. Russell dec'd & return the appraisement under their hands as the law directs.

Thomas Kasher, Warden of Kentucky & Kasher dec'd. with the approbation of the Court, made choice of W. T. Bradshaw as his Guardian, & thereupon the said Bradshaw together with W. T. Bradshaw his Securities (who justified in Oath as to their sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded.

The Court did appoint C. C. Ferguson, Overseer of the Poor, in the some Magisterial District, in this County, to fill the vacancy existing in said Office by the failure of the said Ferguson to qualify thereon, within the time prescribed by law, & thereupon the said C. C. Ferguson together with John J. Geyer his Security (who justified in Oath as to their sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars, Conditioned according to law, which bond is ordered to be recorded. And thereupon the said Ferguson took the several Oaths required by law.

On the Motion of John C. Davis Guardian for Under Priggs & others in ex parte, it is ordered that the said Guardian be allowed to Capsum One hundred dollars, out of the principal of his debt to Under Priggs for his benefit.
