

And it is Ordered, that the Sheriff of this County do, as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court, remove and safely convey the said William to the jail of this Court to the Prisoner, in the Commonwealth, where he is to be kept, imprisoned, and located in the manner directed by law. And thereupon the said William is remanded to jail.

Chief Carrell also stands indicted of felony, does live in the town of Castledy of the jail of this Court and being thereof assigned pleads not guilty to the Indictment, and a process of return follows by the sheriff by the Sheriff returned by the Court, from the jail all legal exceptions and qualifications to serve as jury according to law, thereupon the accused presents a challenge of four of the jurors and the remaining twelve to wit, J. H. [unclear], L. City, Carr, Reade, W. H. Lawrence, R. P. [unclear], E. J. [unclear], J. [unclear], Bishop, Jas. T. [unclear], O. S. [unclear], R. N. [unclear], Wm. [unclear], Wm. [unclear], and W. [unclear], also being elected true and sworn the trust of and upon the promises to speak, and having heard the evidence, upon their Oath do say, "That the jury find the said Carrell guilty and ascertain the term of his imprisonment in the Prisoner to be five years." And thereupon it being demanded of him if he has anything for himself he has a word to say, why the Court have should not proceed to pronounce judgment against him according to law, and finding being Officer or alleged in delay of judgment, it is therefore considered by the Court that the said Chief Carrell be imprisoned in the Prisoner of this Commonwealth for the term of five years, the period by the jurors in their verdict ascertained. And it is Ordered that the Sheriff of this County do as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court, remove and safely convey the said Chief Carrell from the jail of this Court to the Prisoner of this Commonwealth, where he is to be kept, imprisoned, and located in the manner directed by law. And thereupon the said Chief Carrell is remanded to jail.
