The last will & Testament of H. P. Kipp dec. of the Codicils thereto annexed was presented to the Court for probate, of which said will was proved by the Oaths of Joseph E. Bailey, & W. P. Bell, the subscribing witnesses thereof, & the Codicil dated July 12th 1877, was proved by the Oaths of J. L. Bashaw & J. E. Bailey, the subscribing witnesses thereof, & the Codicil dated August 13th 1877, was proved by the Oaths of Wm. L. Gray & C. W. Kipp, the subscribing witnesses thereof. All of said will & Codicils, and ordered to be recorded. And further H. P. Kipp, the Executor therein named, refusing to take upon himself the burden of affording security thereof, in the opinion of H. P. Kipp, J. B. Kipp, & H. Kinnis, four of the Executors named in the said will, who made Oath according to law, & severally entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty five thousand dollars, each, conditioned according to law, which said bonds are ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted to said H. P. Kipp, J. B. Kipp, & H. Kinnis, for obtaining a probate of the said will & Codicils in due form, being duly examined in this to wit: that the same are in due form, being duly examined in the said probate court & in due form. The Executor not being required to give security in the said will, the Court requires none.

The Commissioners appointed at the August term last of this Court to view the Bridge across Applewhite's Mill run, this day made their report concerning the same, which is satisfied & confirmed by the Court & ordered to be recorded.
