

John J. Dejeu, acknowledged themselves to be guilty as in the presentment against them is alleged & agreed that judgment may be entered against them for the last four & costs. Therefore with the consent of the Attorney for the Commonwealth, it is considered by the Court that the Commonwealth recover against the defendants One Cent fine, each, & the costs of this prosecution.

W. H. Kell, Curator of this County, this day made a report specifying the duties & bonds of a certain tract of Land charged in the Commonwealth's Book to Richard Semmes, a field upon sold for the use of payment of Sarah, David Land being in Southampton County, Va. according to the provisions of Section 19, Chapter 38 Code of Virginia, 1873, which is ordered to be recorded.

The Commonwealth appointed to let to the Court undertake the repairing or repairs of the Bridges at the Outbankment at the west side of Abington River, at Jerusalem, & to repair the railing & make gates to the public square, this day made their report receiving the same, which is ratified & confirmed by the Court & ordered to be filed.

Ordered that the following accounts be paid, One in favor of Mr. Josephine F. Howard, Jailor of this County, amounting to Fifty four ²⁵/₁₀₀ dollars, & One in favor of Samuel Long, Special Constable, amounting to Ten ⁹⁰/₁₀₀ dollars, be & are hereby Certified to the Treasurer of Public Accounts for his examination & payment.

Ordered that the account of Mr. Josephine F. Howard, Jailor of this County, amounting to fifty four ²⁵/₁₀₀ dollars, for the maintenance of Cars of Julia M. Ligon & Mariah Bowman, females Confined in the Jail of this County, it being proved to the Court that immediately after the Commitment of the said Julia M. Ligon & Mariah Bowman, & at least once in every ten months thereafter, application was made to the Board of Directors of the Asylums for admission of said girls, application was refused for want of room.

The Account of Miss Crumpler, Curator of Road, in Precinct No. 1, amounting to Sixty two ²⁵/₁₀₀ dollars, is allowed & ordered to be Certified to the Board of Supervisors for payment.

The Account of Mr. A. C. Griffin, Curator of Road, in Precinct No. 1, amounting to Twelve ¹⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars, is allowed & ordered to be Certified to the Board of Supervisors for payment.

Ordered that Jas. C. Selmer, Treasurer of this County, do of the County pay to Charles H. Semmes, Special Policeman, Sixty ²⁵/₁₀₀ dollars for his services as such Policeman, from April Court last to December 17th 1877.

Ordered that Wm. H. Kell, Wm. Selmer, & Jas. C. Kell do and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to examine & report to Court the yearling
