Junius Paolo, who stands indicted for felony, this day appeared in Court in  
 discharge of his recognizance entered in before David H. Winder and  
 R. P. Barrett, two Justices of the Peace of this County, & was led to a bar  
 in Custody of the Sheriff & being there arraigned pleaded not guilty to  
 the Indictment of a parcel of Letters passing of the Sheriff, which were examined by the Court, found free from all legal exception  
 & qualified to serve as jurors according to law. Thereupon the accused  
 peremptorily challenged four of the jurors, & the remaining twelve to wit

 Gen. A. Richardson, Geo. T. Camp, Oley Bryant, James P. Kibler, Charles  
 Parkman, Edwin Williams & V. H. Cobb, who being called took & sworn  
 the Court to speak upon the issue, & having heard the evidence  
 upon their Oath do say, "We the Jury find the Prisoner not guilty." And  
 thereupon proclamation being made as the manner is of taking further  
 appearing or being alleged against the said Junius Paolo, it is considered  
 by the Court that the said Junius Paolo, be acquitted & discharged of the felony  
 of which he stands charged, & go thereof without day

Ordered that James E. Sebrell, Treasurer of this County, out of  
 the County Levy, pay the following accounts to wit, One in favor  
 of A. C. Burns, Edwin Williams & James T. Darrow for four dollars each  
 One in favor of William Williams, Thomas Langdon, & Isaac J. King &  
 J. H. Pedersen, for two dollars each, & One in favor of  
 Josephine T. Concord amounting to five dollars, the same being for  
 conveying Prisoners, & for the board of said gaol
