The Hon. J. W. Fitzgerald, Judge,

(Sealed & co.) The last will & Testament of Joseph J. Crumpler dec. was filed
proved by the oath of Geo. W. Brown Jr. the other Subscribing witness
thereof, & Ordered to be recorded. And Elizabeth C. Crumpler, the
Caroline Maria Ward, refusing to take upon herself, the burden of the
execution thereof, on the Motion of Josiah S. Gay, who made oath
according to law, & together with C. C. Vaughan, his Security,
(Who justified on oath as to his Sufficiency) entered into
and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five hundred
dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, Which said is Ordered
to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Josiah S. Gay
for obtaining letters of administration, on the Estate of Joseph
J. Crumpler dec. with his well annexed, in due form.

Annie J. Crumpler, Daughter of Joseph J. Crumpler dec. with the appor-
tion of the Court, made choice of Josiah S. Gay as her Guardian, & thereupon
the said Josiah S. Gay, together with C. C. Vaughan, his Security, (Who just-
ified on oath as to his Sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in
the penalty of Five hundred dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, Which
said is Ordered to be recorded.

The Court doth appoint Josiah S. Gay Guardian of Elizabeth Maria
Crumpler & Antimilla Barbara Crumpler Daughters of Joseph J. Crumpler
dec. And thereupon the said Josiah S. Gay, together with C. C. Vaughan,
his Security, (Who justified on oath as to his Sufficiency) entered into
and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five hundred dollars,
Conditioned as the law directs, Which said is Ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that C. C. Vaughan, A. L. Gardner, Frank Holden & S. B. Eddies
(any two of whom may act) being first duly sworn for the purpose, do
appraise all the goods and chattels of Joseph J. Crumpler dec. and
return the appraisement under their hands, as the law directs.
