The Commisary of the Revenue for District Court in this County, this day made report, to the Court, in accordance with the 8th Section of Chapter 253 of the acts of assembly 18th July 77, approved March 26th 1877, Page 250, which report is Ordered to be filed.

The Commisary appeared at the January Term last of this Court to assign to John A. Howard his name in the real estate of his late husband Joseph B. Howard and this day made report, which is filed for exceptions.

On the motion of Jas. E. Howell, who made Oath according to law of regular and Wm. A. Roberts, Jas. H. Johnson his Surety, (who justified on Oath as to their Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred Dollars which bond is Ordered to be recorded. Certificate of grant of the bond to be filed for obtaining letters of administration ^{de bene non, except the said amount} in the estate of John B. Roberts deceased in due form. The rights of Harriette Holland, the former executrix, being extinguished by her intermarriage with Jas. E. Johnson.

The Court did approve Mary E. Kellings as Guardian of Martha Ann, Adeline Henry, Geo. Kellings, Children of Wm. A. Kellings deceased and Harriette the said Mary E. Kellings together with A. A. Williams, John S. Sumner, her Sureties, (who justified on Oath as their Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars, conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.

Clark Knight having gone before Just. H. P. a Justice of the Peace of this County, & made Complaint that William S. Fuller is justly indebted to him in the sum of Sixty five dollars which became payable on the 1st day of January 1878, that the said William S. Fuller has now at this time a Cart of apples and a duck bag, upon at Byrnsford Dept Southampton Co Va and that the said William S. Fuller intends to remove the said Cart of apples and duck bag out of this County so that there will probably not be shown sufficient effects to satisfy the said claim of Sixty five dollars of said Knight, whereupon the ordinary process of law be used to obtain such judgment, & the Justice having issued an attachment to attach the said Cart of apples & duck bag to Philip Carroll Constable thereof, and the said Constable having made return on said attachment that he had attached a Cart, which the property of William S. Fuller. This day came the parties to this attachment, for reason appearing to the Court, it is Ordered that this Case be continued until the first day of the next term of this Court.

The Court did appoint Charles H. Sumner a Special Messenger for this County, & thereupon the said Sumner qualified by taking the Oath required by law.

Ordered that John A. Roberts, A. J. Gardner, & A. H. Spradley (being first duly sworn for the purpose) do approve all the goods and chattels of Wm. A. Kellings deceased and return the same under their hands as the law directs.
