Copy to be made of R.R. Griffin, who has been Commissioner & Solary Kuller for this County, by virtue of a Commission from the Governor of Virginia, under the seal of the Commonwealth, bearing date the 12th day of March, A.D. 1878, this day said R.R. Griffin, his Secretary, (who justified as Court as to his sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five Hundred Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded.

And the said Griffin, also took the Oath required by law.

(See p. 100) The last will & testament of Charles B.C. Brindle, was proved by the Oaths of Bury E. Horne & Eugene A. Hunt, the two subscribing witnesses thereof, & ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of J. P. T. McLean & George Spriggs for obtaining approval of the said will in due form, the executing therein James J. Hunt, who reads Court according to law of said will, & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One Thousand Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, (but without security, the wife disclaiming that no pecuniary interest be required, & the Court requiring none) which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said J. P. McLean & George Spriggs for obtaining approval of the said will in due form.

Ordered that B.E. Horne, R.D. Barker & J.H. Barker (being first duly sworn for the purpose) do appraise all the goods & Chattels of Charles B.C. Brindle dec'd. & return the appraisement under their hands as the law directs.

On the motion of W.H. Goodenow & Charles Smith, it is ordered that W.H. Briggs, Sheriff of this County, take into his hands the estate of George M. Howard dec'd. & administer the same as the law directs.

On the motion of Henry Vaughan, & for reasons appearing to the Court, he is exempted from the payment of Taxes & dues in future, he being aged & infirm.

(See p. 101) On the motion of M.G. Knight, who reads Court according to law of said will of Charles Knight & B.T. Knight, his Secretary (who justified as Court as to his sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One Hundred Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said M.G. Knight for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John & Daughters dec'd. in due form.

Ordered that J.R. Boyant, R.D. McTear & E.B. Spearon (being first duly sworn for the purpose) do appraise all the goods & Chattels of John & Daughters dec'd. & return the appraisement under their hands as the law directs.

The Court doth appoint M.G. Knight, Guardian of Charles & James Daughters, Orphans of John & Daughters dec'd. And thereupon the said M.G. Knight, together with Charles Knight & B.T. Knight his Secretary, (who justified as Court as to their sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five Hundred Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded.
