

Dead District, in the place of J. P. Gay, resigned.

J. B. Pope is appointed Register, at Oak Grove, Vermont, in the place of H. B. Gardner, resigned.

The Court doth appoint A. A. Holland a Justice of the Peace in the place of Walter B. Holland dec. in Franklin County District, and thereupon the said A. A. Holland, qualified by taking the Oath required by law.

On the special report of Comr. James R. Tyler filed May 1878, and reporting that J. B. Pope one of the Hrs of H. P. Pope dec. has in his hands the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars, belonging to the estate of the said Pope, and desiring to be instructed by the Court, in what manner he shall invest the said money, the Court doth hereby order that the said J. B. Pope, invest the said sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars in bonds of either the City of Norfolk, Petersburg, Richmond, or Lynchburg, or in Registered bonds of the United States, but the said Hrs is not authorized to pay a higher premium for any of said bonds than four per cent. Or if the said Hrs can find judicious investment for the said sum on real estate, he is hereby authorized to loan out the same or any part thereof, provided that in every such instance, the real estate shall be unencumbered, and its assessment, at least, fifty per cent more than the amount loaned on the same - and in the event of loans on real estate, the bond or bonds for the same shall be secured by trust deeds in which, if the loanee be a married man, his wife shall join; and provided, in every instance, the real estate shall be wholly situated in this state -.

On the special report of Comr. James R. Tyler, filed May 20. 1878 and reporting that J. B. Pope one of the Hrs of H. P. Pope dec. has in his hands the sum of six thousand dollars, belonging to the estate of the said Pope, and desiring to be instructed by the Court, in what manner he shall invest the same. The Court doth hereby order that the said Hrs of H. P. Pope invest the said sum of six thousand dollars in bonds of either the City of Norfolk, Petersburg, Richmond, or Lynchburg, or in Registered bonds of the United States, but the said Hrs is not authorized to pay for any of said bonds a higher premium than four per cent. Or if the said Hrs can find judicious investment for the said sum on real estate, he is hereby authorized to loan out the same or any part thereof, provided that in every such instance, the real estate shall be unencumbered and its assessment shall be at least fifty per cent more than the amount loaned; and in every event of loans on real

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
