

Applicants having executed Bonds as required by law, and given Security, payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in a sum of Five hundred dollars, Conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements of the act of the General Assembly, entitled, "An Act imposing a tax, and prescribing the Mode of Collecting the Same on the privilege of Selling Wine, Brandy, & other spirituous Liquors, within the Limits of the Commonwealth for the support of the Government & to pay the interest on the Public Debt," approved March 30th 1817, as amended by the Act approved April 2nd 1817.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until the first day of the next Term.
