John D. Ryker was upon appointed a Justice of the Peace in the Berlin of New Highgate District in this County in the place of Peter J. McElwain resigned, this day qualified by taking the Oath required by law.

The Report of Commissioners B. H. Fox, J. I. Westbrook, & Benj.
