

In judgment. The last Will and Testament of Elisha Varden dec'd. was proved by the Oaths of John B. Higgins and James Vaughan the undersigned, who after reading and perusing the same and in the presence of Rufus E. On motion of Geo. W. Prince and Francis his wife, and formerly Anne Pope and for reasons appearing in the report of Geo. E. Wells, Executor of Geo. E. Pope dec'd. in Oath by his Counsel during the notice required by law, to be given to him, it is ordered that such and such Decrees be and they are hereby revoked.
