Kinnor & David Turner, be & they are hereby appointed Commissioners to confer with the Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Brunswick, and agree with them as to the manner & conditions of letting the repairs of Halsey's Bridge, & report of their proceedings to Court. And it is ordered that the Clerk of this Court certify a Copy of this Order to the Clerk of Brunswick County.

J. H. Johnson, Surveyor of Road No. 100, St. 73, hearing from the Attorney Harris filed to the Woodard place, this day tenders his resignation which the Court accepts & doth appoint Walter Darden in his stead.

J. S. Ridley Jr. Surveyor of Road No. 73, St. 73, from the sign post near the bridge to the bridge, above the Jones Bridge, and his resignation which the Court accepts, & doth appoint J. L. W. Jones in his stead.

J. S. Ridley Jr. Justice of the Peace in the Orangeville Magisterial District, this day tenders his resignation, which the Court accepts.

Thomas C. Cornett, is appointed Justice of the Peace in the Orangeville Magisterial District, in the place of J. S. Ridley resigned, & thereupon the said Cornett, qualified by taking the Oath required by law.
