

Licence is this day granted to S. W. Davis, Jno. P. Ireland,  
Charles Parker and J. B. Drennon on their applica-  
 tion to sell by retail only in quantities up to five gallons  
 at any one time to any one individual, wine, Ardent Spirits,  
 Malt Liquors, Cider, or any mixture thereof, at their  
 several places of business in this County, which shall not be  
 drunk within their houses or cartilage where sold  
 but shall be delivered to the purchaser in bottles, Jugs,  
 Amifobus or other vessels to be removed therefrom for  
 the period beginning on first day of October 1878  
 and expiring on the 30th day of April 1879. The Court  
 being fully satisfied that the applicants were fit per-  
 sons and that their places of business are suitable &  
 convenient, and the applicants having executed bonds  
 as required by law with good security payable to  
 the Commonwealth of Virginia in a penalty of Three  
 Hundred Dollars conditioned for the faithful per-  
 formance of all the requirements of the act, of the Gen-  
 eral Assembly of Virginia entitled, "An Act imposing  
 a Tax, and prescribing the mode of collecting the same  
 on the privilege of selling Wine, Ardent Spirits, or Malt  
 Liquors, within the limits of the Commonwealth, for the  
 support of the Government and to pay the interest on  
 the Public Debt," approved March 30th 1877, as am-  
 ended by the act approved April 2nd 1877
