 drunk within their houses or cartilage where sold
 but shall be delivered to the purchaser in bottles, Jugs,
 Amfibus or other vessels to be removed therefrom for
 the period beginning on first day of October 1878
 and expiring on the 30th day of April 1879. The Court
 being fully satisfied that the applicants were fit per-
 sons and that their places of business are suitable &
 convenient, and the applicants having executed bonds
 as required by law with good security payable to
 the Commonwealth of Virginia in a penalty of Three
 Hundred Dollars conditioned for the faithful per-
 formance of all the requirements of the act of the Gen-
 eral Assembly of Virginia entitled, "An Act imposing
 a tax, and prescribing the mode of collecting the same
 on the privilege of selling wine, Ardent Spirits, or Malt
 Liquors, within the limits of the Commonwealth, for the
 support of the Government and to pay the interest on
 the Public Debt," approved March 30th 1877, as am-
