Thomas H. Harrison here in Court acknowledged himself to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia the sum of One ~~Hundred~~ ^{Fifty} Dollars of his several goods & chattels, lands & tenements to be levied to the use of the Commonwealth, that upon this condition if the said Thomas Harrison shall make his personal appearance before the Judge of this Court on the first day of the next term thereof, and give such evidence as he may know on behalf of Moore and Riggins charged with felony, and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court then this recognizance to be void otherwise to remain in full force & virtue.

Mat Floyd, who stands bound by recognizance entered into before Benja. H. Everett as Justice of the Peace of this County for his appearance here on the first day of the next term to give evidence on behalf of the Commonwealth against ^{J. E.} Moore, and Riggins was solemnly coerced but came not. Whereupon it is ordered that a writ of Scire Facias be issued against the said Mat Floyd returnable here to the first day of the next term.

On the motion of Same W. Hill Surgeon of Precinct no. in newswome Magisterial District the Court doth appoint James Barden Jr., Samuel Ferguson and Wm E. Ellyrich to act under section 24th of Chapter 181 of the Acts of Assembly of Virginia 1874 & 1875 to lay off, allot & arrange the said precinct no. - & to allot the lands to work on the same & report to Court their action in the premises.
