Bishop, at their application to sell by retail only in quantities up to five gallons at any one time to any one individual Wine, Ardent Spirits, Malt Liquors, Cider or any Meadous drink, at their several places of business in this County, which shall not be more within the limits of Culpeper when sold but shall be delivered to the purchaser in bottles, jugs, demijohns or other vessels, to be removed from for the period beginning on the 21st day of Oct 1878, & expiring on the shortest day of April 1879, the Court being fully satisfied that the applicants are fit persons & that their place of business and sale are convenient, & the applicants having executed bonds as security for the worth and payment to the Commonwealth of Virginia, on a penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements of the act of the General Assembly of Virginia, intituled "An act imposing a tax and presenting the mode of collecting the same as the privilege of selling Wine, Ardent Spirits or Malt Liquors within the limits of the Commonwealth for the support of the Government & to pay the interest on the public debt," approved April 30th 1877, as amended by the act approved April 2nd 1878.)

The License heretofores granted to W. E. Brantley to keep & sell at his place of business at Brumfield in this County is transferred to W. G. Brantley on his application to sell by the drink in quantities of not more than one half pint not to be taken away from the place of delivery but to be drunk at the place where sold, Wine, Ardent Spirits & Malt Liquors Cider or any Meadous drink at his place of business in this County for the period beginning on the 21st day of October 1878 & expiring on the shortest day of April 1879, the Court being fully satisfied that the applicant is a fit person and that his place of business is suitable and convenient, and the applicant having executed a bond as required by law with due security payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia on a penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements of the act of the General Assembly of Virginia, intituled "An act imposing a tax and presenting the mode of collecting the same as the privilege of selling Wine, Ardent Spirits or Malt Liquors within the limits of the Commonwealth for the support of the Government and to pay the interest on the public debt," approved March 30th 1877 as amended by the Act approved April 2nd 1878.
