Holland in his lifetime in his place & name of let in Bankrupt proceedings the same do not exceed the sum of Two Hundred dollars, & that the said Store keeper of let be held by the said Widow of minor children of W. B. Holland, as a Homestead. When the said Debt is paid off, the said C. C. Vaughan, shall take release & debt, in which the said Store keeper and let will be conveyed to the said Widow of minor children, discharged of the claim of the aforesaid bond debt, as a Homestead, subject to the limitations and conditions of the Statute, declaring in what manner and in what conditions a Homestead may be set apart of. And the said C. C. Vaughan will report to Court, a Copy of this Order is Ordered to be served upon the said Vaughan.
