

The faithful performance of all the requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia intituled, "An act imposing a tax of prescribing the mode of collecting the same, at the privilege of selling Wine, Spirits, or Malt Liquors, within the limits of the Commonwealth, for the support of the Government & to pay the interest on the Public Debt," approved March 30th 1877, as amended by the act approved April 2^d 1877.

Whereas this day granted Gen. F. Harris, on his application, bid by Retail only in quantities of five gallons, at any one time, to any one individual, Wine, Alcohol Spirits & Malt Liquors, Order in a Mixture thereof, at his place of business at New Bern, Carteret County, North Carolina, in the County which shall not be County of the town or City where bids, but shall be delivered to the purchasers in bottles, jugs, demijohns, or other vessels, to be remitted therefrom for the period beginning at the 16th day of December, 1878, and expiring at the thirtieth day of April 1879, the Court being fully satisfied that the applicant is a fit person, & that the place of business is suitable, convenient, & the applicant having executed a bond at requirement of the said Sheriff payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in a penalty of One Hundred dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, intituled, "An act imposing a tax of prescribing the mode of collecting the same on the privilege of selling Wine, Spirits, or Malt Liquors, ordered to the Senate of the Commonwealth, for the support of the Government & to pay the interest on the Public Debt," approved March 30th 1877, as amended by the act approved April 2^d 1877.
