Let the Hon. of John J. Taylor, Commissioner of the Revenue for District No. 112 in this County this day read this report in accordance with the 24th of Chapter 533 of the Acts of Assembly 1876 & 77, approved March 20th 1877, which reports are Orderd to be filed.

A Writing bearing date the 20th day of November 1870, purporting to be the last will & Testament of Peter Jackson dec. was this day proved by the Oath of Geo. C. Beaton One of the Subscribing Witnesses thereto, of M. H. Williams the other Subscribing Witness being dead, Geo. C. Beaton also sworn as a Witness & declared that he was well acquainted with the handwriting of the said M. H. Williams, & truly believe that the name of the said M. H. Williams to the said will subscribed as a Witness, is in his own proper handwriting. Whereupon it is Orderd that the said Writing bearing date as aforesaid, be recorded as the true last will & Testament of the said Peter Jackson dec.

On the Motion of Geo. C. Beaton who made Oath according to law. For \$1.00 paid & together with \$1.00 M. Beaton his Security (Who justified on Oath as to his Sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five Hundred Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs. Which bond is Orderd to be recorded. Whereupon is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of M. H. Williams dec. as directed by law.

George C. Beaton, who has been Commissioner & Notary Public, for this County, by a Commission from the Governor of Virginia, dated 28th (Feb) 1878, with the Supers Seal of the Commonwealth annexed, this day wrote Geo. W. Harrison this Security (Who justified on Oath as to his Sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five Hundred Dollars Conditioned as the law directs, Which bond is Orderd to be recorded. And the said Geo. C. Beaton also took the Oath required by law.

On the application of James H. Hardin & L. J. Plummer, who desire to distribute a Tith religious Borty, Newspaper &c and the Court being satisfied that they are persons of good character & proper persons in whom to confide the truth of selling & distributing said Borty, doth direct the Commissioners of the Revenue to grant them license with a Special Com.
