

The Court doth appoint Geo. H. Magist. Constable in Townshend Magisterial District, in this County, to fill the vacancy existing in said Office, & to act as such until the expiration of the term of his Office, & then after notice his Successor is duly qualified to enter upon the discharge of the duties of said Office. Thereupon the said Geo. H. Magist. together with J. S. Jones, R. B. Hurdock, Geo. E. Beaton, James R. Kello, C. C. Ferguson, Jas. E. Seibel, his Trustees, (who justified the Court as to their Sufficiency) into & acknowledged & bind in the penalty of Two Thousand dollars, conditioned as the said Court required by law.

Jones, for the year 1877, & forty dollars, each for his wards Pauline & Leggie Jones, for the years 1874, 1877 & thirty dollars for his ward R. J. Jones, at the principle of their said Estates for their board & clothing &c.

On the motion of W. W. Briggs Adm'r of Britton Burgess dec'd. he is allowed to expend Five dollars, of the principal due from said Estate to Geo. W. Burgess, for his maintenance for the year 1877.

Ordered that James H. Barnes, Rufus J. Turner, & Geo. W. Turner, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to let to the County under the act of the last General Bridge near Holston Church, & report to Court.
