

✓ License is this day granted to R. H. Dardain, Josephine T. Howard, R. H. Tiff-
R. C. Darden, J. G. Thomas, P. G. Gillette, J. E. Bailey by S. B. Drury, on their applica-
tion to sell by Retail only in quantities up to five gallons at any one time to any one and
Retail Wine, Ardent Spirits, Malt Liquors, Oder, or any mixture thereof at their place
of business in this County which shall be drunk within the limits of this place
sold but shall be delivered to the purchaser in bottles, jugs, demijohns, or other vessels
to be returned therewith for the period beginning at the 1st day of May 1877, and
expiring at the thirtieth day of April 1878, the Court being fully satisfied that the
applicants are fit persons, and that their places of business are suitable and convenient
and the applicants having executed bond as required by law, with good Security, payable to
the Commonwealth of Virginia, in a penalty of Five Hundred dollars, Conditioned for the
faithful performance of all the requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia
entitled "An act imposing a tax and providing for the mode of collecting the same, and
privileges of selling Wine, Ardent Spirits & Malt Liquors, within the limits of the
Commonwealth for the support of the Government & to pay the interest on the public
debt" approved March 25th 1877, is amended by the act approved April 2nd 1877, and
is amended to $\frac{1}{2}$ to and approved April 15th 1877.

✓ License is granted to Mr. Josephine T. Howard & R. C. Darden, or their applica-
tions to keep and maintain, to furnish, for Compensation, lodging and diet to travelers,
Sailors, or seafarers, in their house, or premises for a board feeding in this State or
on his boat, (except a crew of two Master and persons attending it,) and also, to sell by
the drink in quantities of not more than One half pint, not to be taken away from
the place of delivery, but to be drunk at the place where sold Wine, Ardent Spirits, Malt
Liquors, Oder & any mixture thereof in their place of business in this County for the
period beginning on the 1st day of May 1877 & expiring on the thirtieth day of
April 1878, the Court being fully satisfied that the applicants are persons of good
and good character and that the place where said Premises are to be kept are
convenient and suitable, and that they are provided with the necessary accommodations
for men or horses & provided in the 1st Section of the act imposing taxes
approved March 25th 1877, and the applicant having executed bond as required
by law with good Security payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in a penalty
of Five Hundred dollars, Conditioned for the faithful performance of all the
requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, entitled "An act
imposing a tax and providing for the mode of collecting the same, or the portion of
the Commonwealth for the support of the Government and to pay the interest on the Public Debts"
approved March 25th 1877, as amended by the act approved April 2nd 1877, and
as amended by the act approved April 15th 1877.
